

Where to apply product in the home

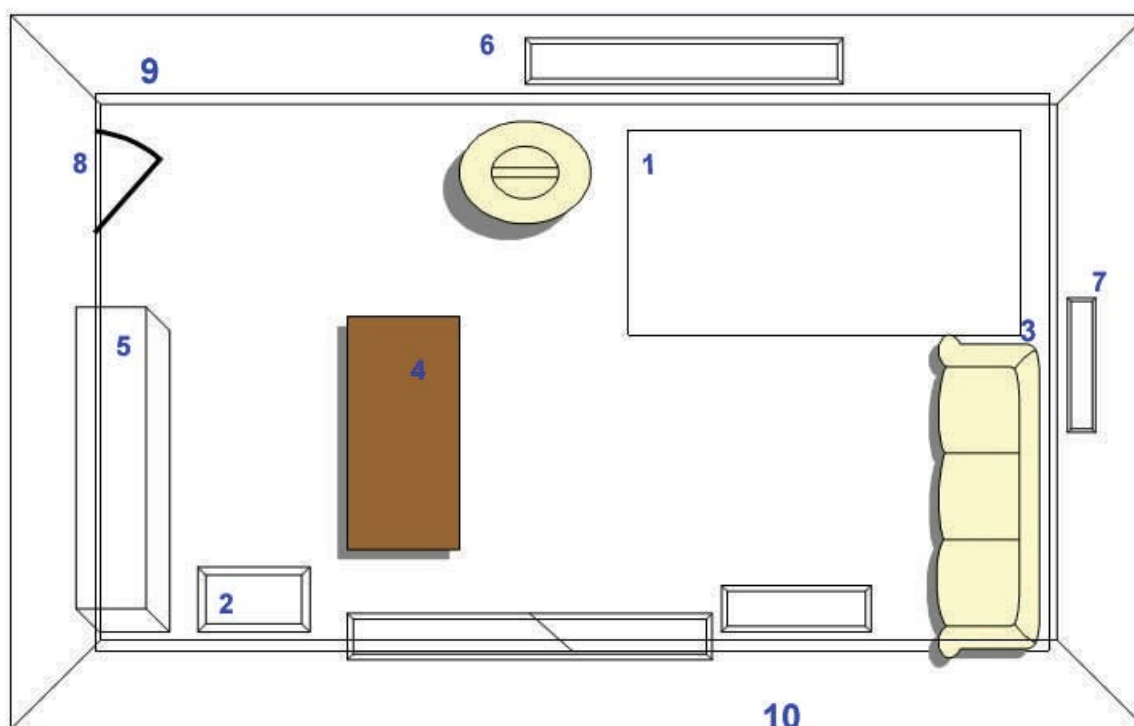
Typical room shown : as per diagram

It is not necessary to coat entire walls. If protecting your room from insects such as Mosquitoes, areas to be treated with Vectorcide should include:

1. **Bed** : paint around all wooden areas of bed and headboard - this will kill disease carrying insects.
2. **Chests of drawers**: paint in and out and behind.
3. Make sure you cover the areas which are dark behind sofas etc..
4. **Coffee table**: paint underneath and in dark recesses.
5. **Cupboards**: paint inside /outside of all areas of the cupboards.

6. **Windows**: paint around the windows and inside frame.
7. **Picture frames**: paint around and behind the picture frames
8. **Door frames** :paint around the door frames - if door is wooden painting the door would also help.
9. **Skirting boards**: paint all skirting boards as this will inhibit any crawling insects such cockroaches. Also paint into any cracks.
10. **Walls and ceilings**: paint a 500ml strip at the top of all walls into the ceiling.

Additionally, particular attention should be paid to areas of the home such as kitchens (under cookers, refrigerators and floors) and any area where food or rubbish is deposited.



FLYING INSECTS

This category represents one of the key targets as it includes the carriers of Malaria, Yellow Fever, Dengue Fever, Chikungunya and Chagas.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Mosquitoes tend to prefer shaded areas. As such specific locations to be coated with Vectorcide should include a strip along the top of walls where they meet the ceiling as well as dark recesses and concealed areas behind ward- robes, picture frames, flower pots, curtains, head boards, wooden beds and un- dersides of furniture such as tables. For *Triatoma* all cracks and crevices in walls should be treated. For moths the interiors of wardrobes should be treated.

CRAWLING INSECTS

These include cockroaches, beetles, spiders, ants, termites, silverfish, weevils. To effectively deal with cockroaches, skirting boards and dark or shaded areas at ground level, particularly under refrigerators, should be treated. For weevils the interiors of food storage cupboards and wardrobes should be coated with Vectorcide.
